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Welcome to the SYA Training Calendar for 2017/2018, please remember that participating in training, along with your level of young people's engagement in activity and programme planning, all contribute towards your Bronze, Silver or Gold Youth Club Award. The award level is clearly marked on the training calendar in the 'Course Title' column.

FREE TRAINING IN YOUTH WORK FOR VOLUNTEERS

Level 2 and Level 3 Certificate in Youth Work - Those wishing to undertake the Level 3 Certificate must be able to evidence that they have completed the Level 2 Award in Youth Work practice. We are also delivering Young Leaders' Awards in developing skills in working with young people. For more information about course content please see the information sheets attached.

Safeguarding – Raising awareness in safeguarding young people. A course designed to develop your knowledge of safe working practice, signposting to relevant agencies and offering advice and support. This course uses relevant case studies & scenario's to enable you to recognise the signs & symptoms of abuse and the pathway to referral.

The above courses are free of charge to Affiliated Voluntary Youth Clubs. However, please note that you may be charged for the registration fee for Level 2 & 3 in Youth Work, if you are not able to commit and complete the full course.

All of the above courses are free to Voluntary Youth Groups who receive all of their support from us. However, owing to changes in our contract with Shropshire Council, from April 2017, we regret that we may not be able to offer free training to groups who are not solely dependent upon SYA. We will endeavour to keep any charges to a minimum.

OTHER COURSES AVAILABLE AT A SMALL COST

Child Exploitation on Line Protection training (CEOP)

This course will develop your skills to help you to deliver internet safety within your youth club. This course is also good for raising your own self awareness of the importance of internet safety. Cost £10 per person

Drugs & Alcohol Awareness

A knowledge based workshop centred on the effects of Drugs & Alcohol enabling you to explore issues around drugs & alcohol within a Youth Work setting.

Cost £10 per person

(Please note that this training is free for students undertaking the Level 3 Certificate in Youth Work as it is one of the course modules.)

1st Aid – Emergency one day course

Cost £40 per person (please note that usual costs for this accredited course are in excess of £90 with other providers)

Food Hygiene – Level 1

Safe practice in preparing food within your Youth Club. Cost £35 per person. Owing to low numbers this year, we will book this once we have sufficient numbers. Please register your interest with Kerry.

This Course is aimed at older club members 13+, to help them become young leaders.

The course includes workshops on:

- What is a young leader
- How to run an activity or club night
- Safeguarding – How to keep yourself and others safe
- Young people's emergency 1st aid
- CEOP how to keep yourself and others safe on line.

This course aims to increase your self confidence and support you to take a more active role in helping the youth club leaders to run the club. It consists of 2 full days of fun interactive workshops with trained youth workers.

Bespoke training

1st Aid – one day course

This is the minimum requirement for a youth work setting, delivered in an interactive and informal day session giving you the skills and confidence to deal with Emergency 1st Aid. The course covers unresponsive and non breathing patients and what to do/choking/bleeding/seizures burns & scalds plus a book to take away for future reference.

Cost £45 per person

Raising Awareness in Safeguarding – 3 hours

Kerry Williams is our designated safeguarding officer and is trained and approved to deliver the Shropshire Safeguarding Childrens Board (SSCB) course. This will help you recognise your own roles within safeguarding, identify referral pathways and what to look out for to ensure safe working practice. The course uses video's, quizzes and visual aids as well as serious case reviews to enhance your learning experience.
